State of the Art Facilities: The airport will feature improved infrastructure with enabling technology and facilities designed to provide seamless travel experience and efficient operations.



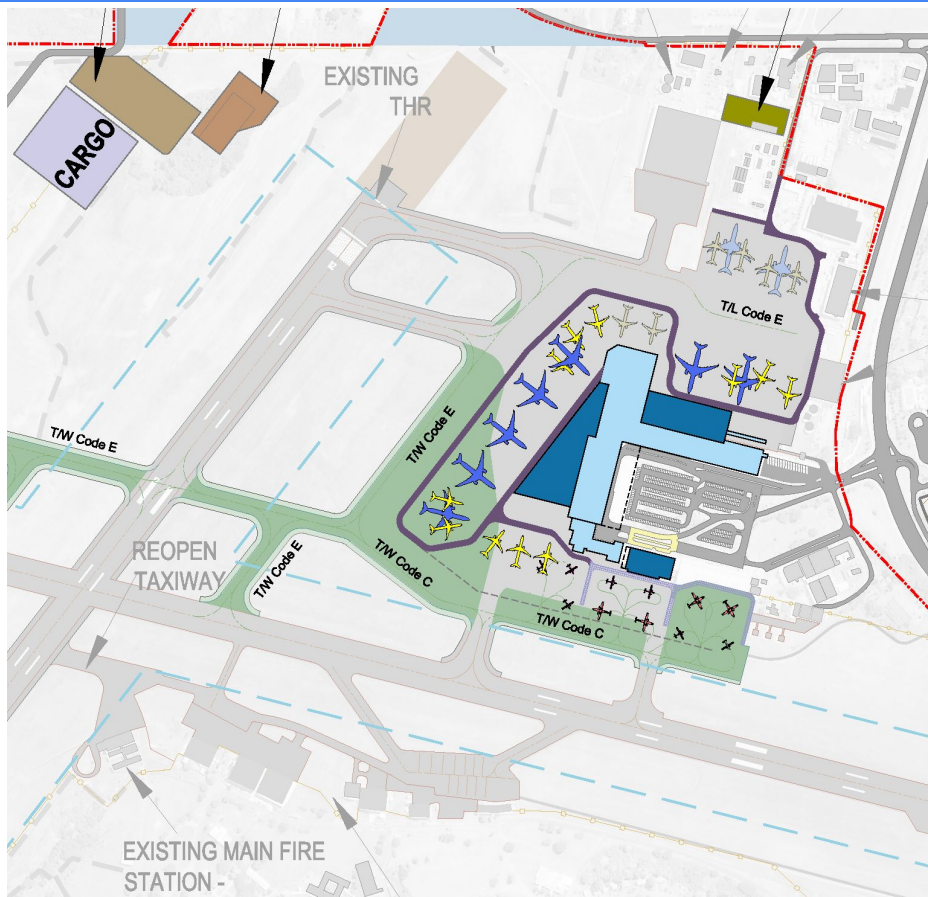

2028 PLAN – TERMINAL AREA



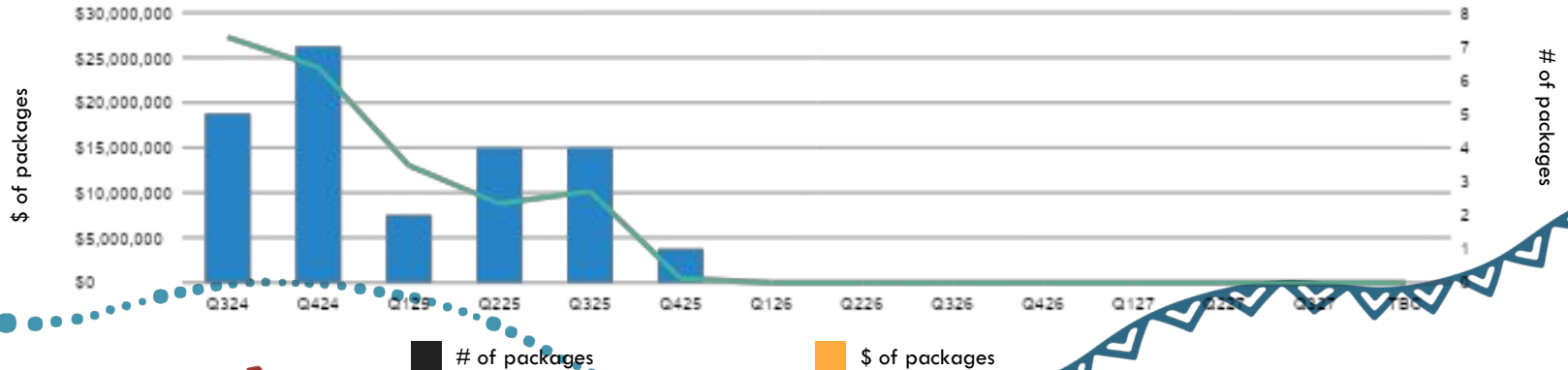

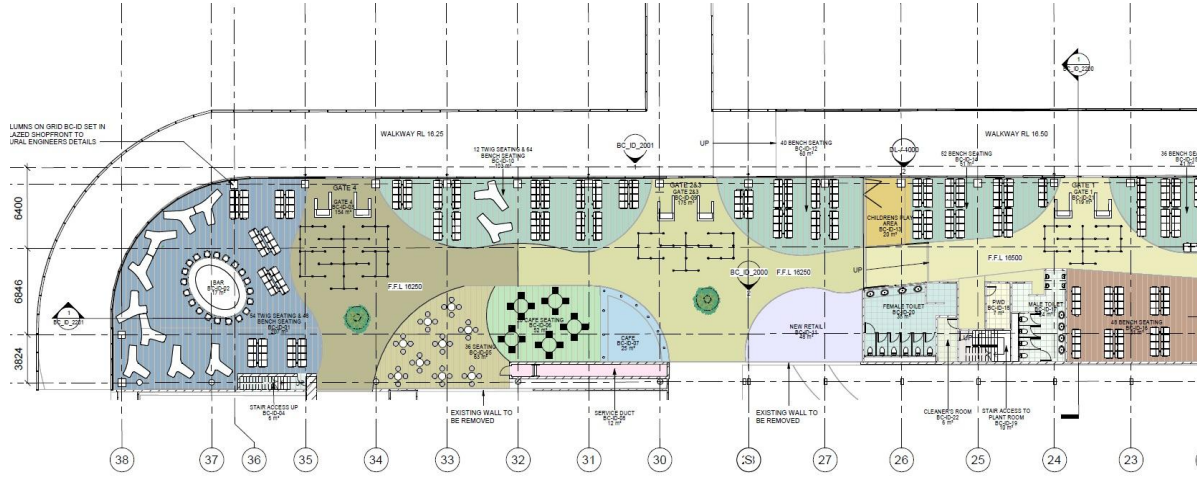

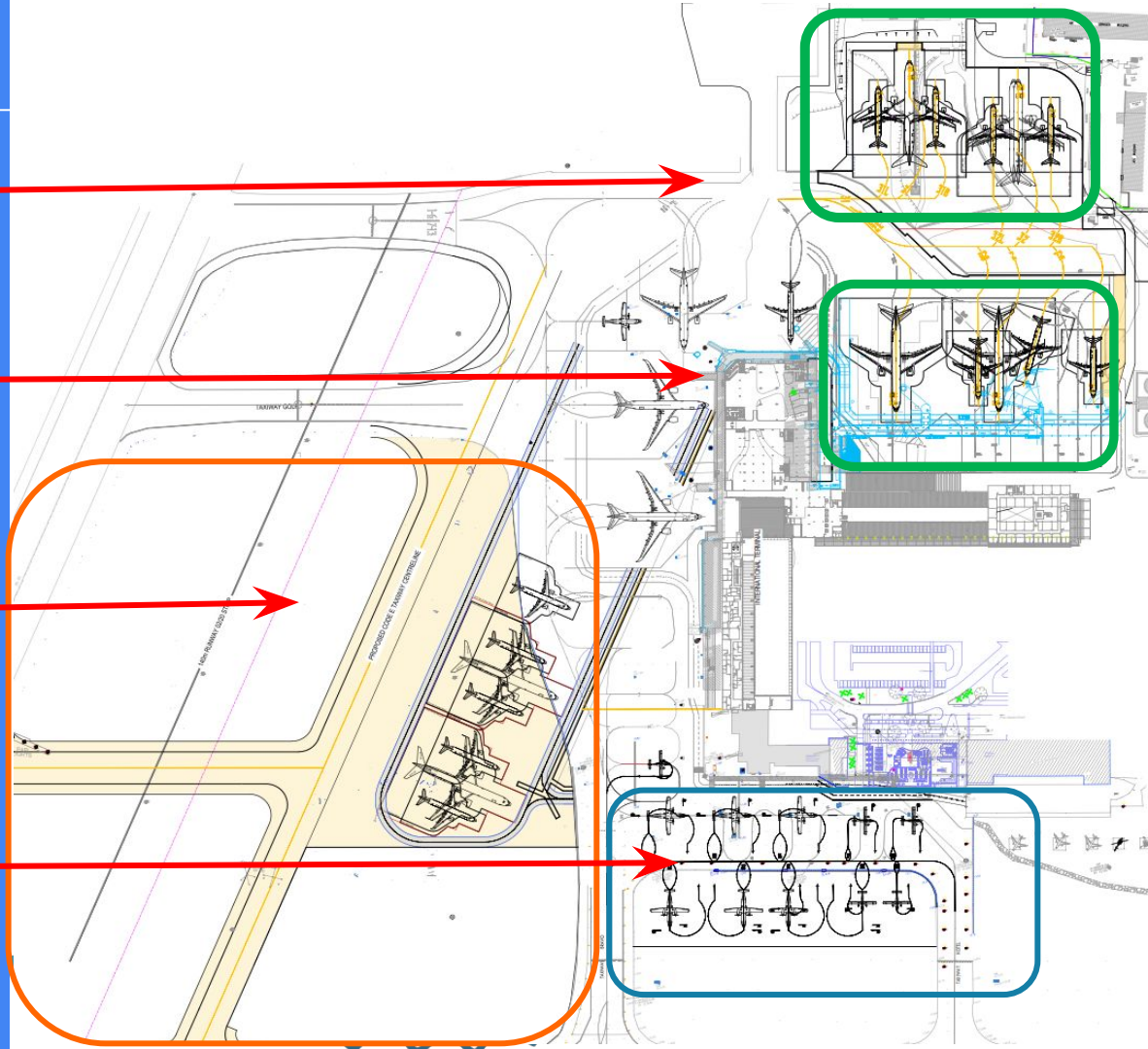

New Gate 2 (MARS), Relocation of Gate 1 (Code C), and Gate 3 (Code E) – 2025-2028

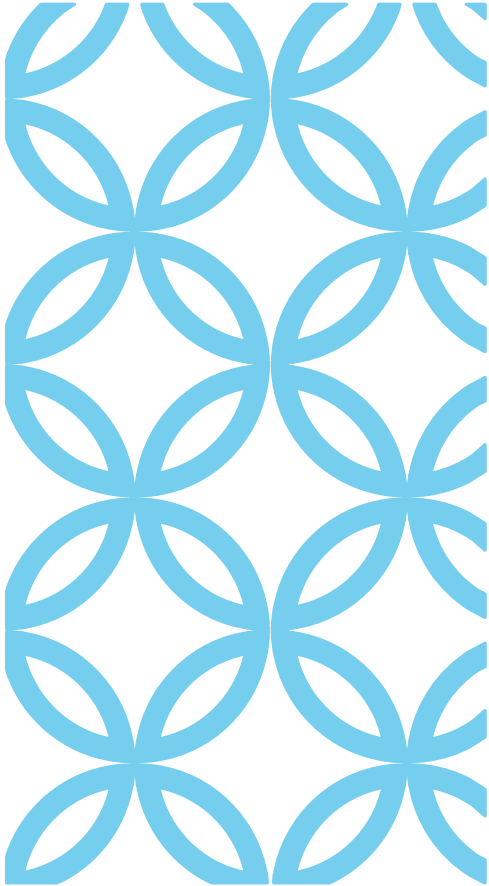
New Gates 10 & 11 (MARS), New Gate 9 (Code C) – 2029-2030
